Dear Parents and Carers,

### RE: Moving from Tigers to Pandas

- Moving rooms is an exciting time. You will notice some small differences in pre-school.
- The ratio is 1:8 in pre-school or 1:13 if a level 6 or teacher is present.
- Pre-school also children mix with reception children in the outdoor area
- The children learn more formal phonics and learn to write their name
- You can claim your free hours the term after your child's third birthday
- We don't use the communication chart in pre-school but the newsletter is more detailed
- Speak to your child regarding toileting in the new room and remind them to inform an adult if they need support wiping their bottoms.

Below is a timetable of a typical day in Pandas! The timetable does vary but I hope you find this outline helpful.

8.00 - 8.30	<b>Breakfast</b>
8.30-9.15	Play and welcoming friends
9.15 - 9.30	Welcome songs – carpet session
9.30 – 10.45	Free flow play (indoors and outdoors)
10.45 – 11.15	Gym time for soft play/obstacle course/ ball pit /etc.
11.15 – 11.30	Getting ready for lunch – washing hands
11.30 – 12.30	<b>Lunch (in the School Hall)</b>
12.30 – 12.50	Focus learning session teaching
12.50 – 2.30	Free flow play (indoors and outdoors)
2.30 – 2.50	Phonics
2.50 – 3.30	Free flow play (indoors and outdoors)
3.30 - 4.00	<b>Tea</b>
4.00-5.30	Free flow play (indoors and outdoors)
5.30 – 6.00	Story time – tidy up time

You should attend a meeting with your current toddler room key worker and the new pre-school key worker so that you can all share and handover important information.
